

Tuition Schedule for 2010-2011

All current students who are not in the Partnership Plan will be assigned to the ASSOCIATE level for the 2010-2011 year.

In recent years, the tuition at Central Christian School has represented approximately 70% of the cost of educating a student. The remaining 30% has been funded through Central's committed community and church support. A large portion of this support has been received through Community Service Day, church partnership plans and the generosity of individual donors.

Faced with new realities around us, Central continues to desire to partner in the vision of Christian education with area churches and to clarify what can be expected from working together toward this goal. The following options represent how Central Christian will partner with area churches while being fiscally responsible with the God-given resources extended to us. Each option represents a percentage of the total cost of education the student will be expected to pay.

1. INTERNATIONAL – 100% of the cost of education will be paid by international students. The tuition figure for the 2010-2011 school year is \$10,100. In addition, there will be the expense of boarding with a local family (estimated at \$3,000).

2. STANDARD – 75% of the cost of education will be paid by students coming from our local communities who have no connections to congregations which are intentionally partnering with Central Christian School in any way. Their high school tuition will be \$7,599. In addition to the automatic 25% discount from the cost of education, these families will be eligible to apply for need-based tuition assistance.

3. ASSOCIATE FAMILY – 70% of the cost of education will be paid by students from an Associate Church. An Associate Church will be one which has a person who advocates for the school, choosing one or more of the following ways to support Central Christian School:

- A. Sponsorship - Sponsor a class, teacher, fine arts or vocal group, or sports team. Sponsoring would be defined as intercessory prayer for this group, meet one or more of the identified needs of the group, and appoint a contact person from the church to connect with the group.
- B. Financial support - A church or family could facilitate an auction booth, donate items to the annual fund-raising auction (quilts, services, trips, tickets, furniture, meals, etc.), or even donate and match the selling price for an auction item. In lieu of the above ideas, a church will commit to taking a special offering twice a year, or choose to make a set monthly or yearly dollar commitment to the CCS budget.
- C. Other ideas - Central is open to other ideas that will originate from these groups of supporters. These should be communicated directly to the head administrator who would determine how to make best use of these ideas.

High school tuition for students from an Associate Church will be \$6,999. In addition to this 30% discount from the cost of education, families will be eligible to apply for need-based tuition assistance.

4. PARTNERSHIP CHURCH – 65% of the cost of education will be charged to students attending Partnership Churches. A Partnership Church supports Central students by appointing a church person and by paying all or part of a student's tuition costs.

The church may fund this support by:

- establishing a line item in the annual church budget, or
- establishing an above-budget fund to which all members can contribute, or
- establishing an endowment at the church that would allow money to flow through, or grow the fund to a point where earnings could be drawn off to meet tuition needs each year.

High school tuition for Partnership Church students would be \$6,499. In addition to the 35% tuition discount from cost of education, if the church chooses to pay less than 100% of tuition, families could apply for need-based tuition assistance for the non-covered portion.

In addition to the tuition discount, Partnership Churches have the opportunity to receive a Community Service Day student work group, have a CCS musical group perform during worship or another church event, or have a CCS administrator or faculty member deliver a morning message or meditation for some other type of church function.

FINANCIAL AID

Qualification Guidelines

Central Christian School is committed to working with families to make Christian education affordable. Assistance in the form of Financial Aid is available to students who qualify. In order to protect confidentiality, all financial information is submitted to a third-party company, Family Financial Needs Assessment (FFNA), which will evaluate each situation and provide Central with an objective analysis.

- Assistance is based on financial need.
- Only tuition is covered by tuition assistance. The registration fee and all other fees are the family's obligation.
- Student registration should be completed prior to receiving assistance.
- FFNA applications should be completed and submitted to FFNA by May 10.
- Central Christian School's Financial Aid Committee will review FFNA's recommendation and any additional information submitted. Notification from CCS's business manager of your financial aid status will be given in writing no later than July 1.
- Past due accounts need to be paid in full. Applications will be considered for assistance *after all balances are paid in full*. Requests for exception will be handled by the business manager.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Complete the statement of intent and return it to the enrollment office. *We are unable to process your request without this form.*
2. Mail the FFNA application and the fee in the envelope provided, or submit information online (www.ffna1.com).
 - Family Financial Needs Assessment (FFNA) is an organization that will keep your financial information confidential and will provide Central Christian School with an objective analysis of the financial aid amount for which your family qualifies.
 - Central Christian School's FFNA number is #2747 (requested on the application).
 - Please note that you must include a complete copy of your most recent federal income tax return with your FFNA application.
 - Family Financial Needs Assessment will send a report to Central Christian School.
